



How Portal Searching Works


- **1. Search Databases:**

- The search box will search this group of Gale Discovering Collection, EBSCO Newspaper Source, MAS Ultra School Edition, World Book Online Reference Center together.
- **2. Advanced Search** will allow users to select their own combination of databases to be searched at one time.
Note: Remember to click on Clear Checkmarks to delete previous database selections.
- **3. To search a single database**, begin your search with Databases by Title or Databases by Subject in the left sidebar.



Remote Access

- Research from home, office or on vacation
- Begin your search by using the search box on the opening page or select a database from the subject or title list.
- If you are not at your library, you will be asked to provide your city, zip code and telephone number.



Mobile Access

- ABC-Clio * American Mosaic databases -- Use the portal access to the ABC-Clio database, click on Mobile in the lower right hand corner of the ABC-Clio web page.
- [EBSCO](#) * Use the portal access to the EBSCOhost database, & EBSCO will recognize the device.
- [Gale](#) - You will need your library's location ID and password
- World Book – in process

Check with your home library for IDs and passwords to log-in.

* You should only need city, zip code and phone number.
