Biography

Lois Nettleton was an actress from the Chicago area who had a long and varied career in theater, television and film from 1949 to 2006. Born in Oak Park, Illinois, in 1927 she knew that she wanted to be an actress from an early age, and pursued the profession with dedication. At 16, she graduated from high school and attended the Goodman School of Drama in Chicago. She later moved to New York and attended the Actors Studio. In 1948, she won the Miss Chicago pageant and went on to compete in the Miss America pageant the same year.

Her first professional acting role was her Broadway debut in *The Biggest Thief in Town* in 1949. From there, she went on to have an active theater career in the 1950s. Her first film role was *Period of Adjustment*, in 1962. She continued to work in theater throughout her career, although her later roles tended more towards film and television. She was most prolific in television roles throughout the 1970s and 1980s. Highlights of her career included her performances as Maggie in *Cat on a Hot Tin Roof* (1970), and Blanche DuBois in *A Streetcar named Desire* (1973) for which she received excellent reviews. She won a number of awards throughout her career, including two Emmys for The American Woman: Portraits of Courage (1976) and Insight: A Gun for Mandy (1982-1983). In 1977, she became the first female actor to be honored by the Masquers Club. Her last role was a TV movie, *The Christmas Card* in 2006 for which she won a CAMIE award. Lois Nettleton died on January 18, 2008.

Description

The collection is divided into six series: **Personal and Biographical**, **Publications**, **Productions**, **Photographs**, **VHS** and other **Audio Visual**, and **Memorabilia**.

The **Personal and Biographical** files include short biographies and correspondence, as well as some school work and memorabilia from the Miss Chicago experience. **Publications** include press clippings, divided into production reviews and more general interest articles, and also a fan club publication called *Looking in on Lois*, which is very detailed.

The **Productions** series, has two subseries: Theater and Film/Television, and contains scripts, call sheets for film and television, and programs for plays. The scripts are often annotated by Nettleton, and many of the production files include notes about how she was going to play a specific role/character. The notes were not in any discernable order, so they have been left in the order they were found. All this material is grouped together by production, and arranged in date order.

Photographs are arranged chronologically. The undated/unidentified photographs of Nettleton, some of which were taken prior to the beginning of her acting career, are filed first. The remaining photographs are arranged by production or event in date order. Large format photographs and posters are at the end of this series.

The **Audio Visual** series contains mostly **VHS** recordings of Nettleton's performances. These are arranged alphabetically by performance title. There are also some TV appearances in game shows, telethons and interviews, and a small amount of material in other formats.

Finally, the **Memorabilia** series contains items accumulated during Nettleton's career, including awards won, and her Miss Chicago sash. It also contains a scrapbook documenting her time at the Goodman School of Drama, which records information not found anywhere else in this collection. The scrapbook is in very fragile condition.

Processing Notes:

This collection serves as a record of the life and work of Lois Nettleton and as a resource for researching acting as a profession. The annotated scripts and acting notes that she kept document the way an actor viewed her profession and approached her roles. It could be useful to theatre students both as a general study of the working method of an actor, or also for the student interested in a particular production. At the end of the finding aid there is an alphabetical list of all the titles of the productions, with dates, that are represented in this collection
